Minutes

Call to order: Booster Club President called the meeting to order at 6:31 pm.

Funding Request:

Kaitlyn Chiller attended the meeting and made a funding request for \$500 for TNT/ Winter Formal. Funds will be used for games and prizes for the Masquerade Ball themed dance.

Sherri N. motioned to approve the request. Michelle C. seconded. \$500 approved.

A funding request was made by FFA/ Shane Stender. He could not attend the meeting. FFA has signed up to work concessions.

**Reviewed Booster Club financial needs for upcoming year: We would like to get new BBQ and a shed to store it in to protect it. Jamie Islay would charge us about \$1,000 to build us a shed with a good lock. We could store all dry goods in it. We hope to get BBQ donated, in case we do not we should save about \$900 for a good BBQ. We need to set aside approx. \$2,000. Softball is hoping to purchase new batting cages.

Approved \$1,500 to FFA now. We will revisit again. We would like the dates of the trips and to be kept up to date on other fundraising.

Regina Wood confirmed that student who purchase a \$50 Activity Spectator Pass and later join a winter or spring sport can just pay the difference for the \$85 Activity Fee.

Concessions

We are still struggling to recruit concessions volunteers. Jen G. and Michele M. will draft an email that can be sent to the masses bi-weekly. It will include the sign-up genius link. With the sign-up genius upgrade, we may be able to text as well.

Students who work concessions receive 5 concessions bucks to be used after their shift. There will also be a nightly raffle for the students who worked. If no Club/ sport/ group signed up to work that shift, students can split the tips earned during their shift. They will receive service hours as well.

Fall wrap up for concessions: Jessi will be cleaning out Stadium Concessions, inventorying and ordering to prepare for basketball season.

Raising prices at concessions has been beneficial.

Current concessions volunteer situation is not sustainable. The same Booster Club Members have been working and cannot continue working every shift throughout the next season.

A discussion of what things would look like if Booster Club did not run concessions was held. Regina/ PHS would have to hire a concessions manager to run it.

We could consider simplifying the “offerings” so more volunteers could step in and feel confident working and we would need less volunteers. Possibly only two.

We are having a difficult time identifying how much we actually profit on items.
