

Important Test Information for 2018-2019

PSAT/NMSQT

Juniors: On Wednesday, October 10th from 8:00 a.m. to noon, the Preliminary SAT (PSAT/NMSQT) will be administered at the high school. Juniors who are considering attending college are strongly encouraged to take this test. While it is not a required test, the PSAT/NMSQT is an excellent opportunity to practice taking a college entrance exam. It is also the qualifying test for the National Merit Scholarship Program. Students may sign up in Mrs. Lentz's office beginning on September 12th. SPACE FOR THIS EXAM IS LIMITED, so students should sign up early. The cost of the exam is \$16.00 and must be paid for at the time of sign-up.

ASVAB

Sophomores, Juniors, and Seniors: The Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB) will be given at the high school during the morning of Wednesday, November 7th. The ASVAB is a comprehensive interest and career exploration tool for all students and is required for anyone entering the military. This test is **free of charge**. **New for 2018-2019 is that ALL SOPHOMORES will be taking the ASVAB.** Interested Juniors & Seniors may register for the ASVAB beginning on October 15th in Mrs. Lentz's office.

Advanced Placement® Exams

Juniors and Seniors: The Advanced Placement® (AP®) Exams will take place during the weeks of May 6th – 10th, and May 13th - 17th. Students enrolled in AP® Biology, AP® Calculus AB, AP® Statistics, AP® English Language & Composition, and AP® European History are strongly encouraged to take the AP® Exam for their subject matter, as most colleges and universities award students credit, advanced placement or both on the basis of AP® Exam grades. Each exam costs \$95 and students will have the opportunity to sign up for these exams with Mrs. Lentz beginning on February 25th.

ACT & SAT

See the backside of this sheet for information on the ACT and SAT college entrance exams. Please note that students must register for these tests at the appropriate website as listed on the back.

There will be a special, **FREE administration of the ACT with Writing for ALL JUNIORS at PHS on Tuesday, April 2nd**. Students will register with the guidance office for this specific test session and should not do any sort of registration online. Stay tuned for more information!

ACT & SAT INFORMATION

The ACT and SAT are both national college entrance exams. In addition, the SAT Basic Subject Tests are specialized tests required by some select colleges and universities. (Most schools do not require the SAT Basic Subject Test.) **Check the entrance requirements of the specific college or university to help you determine which test or tests to take.**

Students must register online. Park High School is available for specific testing dates, as noted below. Please check the registration websites regarding other Montana test sites (i.e. Bozeman, Billings, etc.). **Also note that an appropriate photo must be uploaded for either test.**
