

**EXPECTATIONS**

**BEHAVIOR**

**ATTENDANCE**

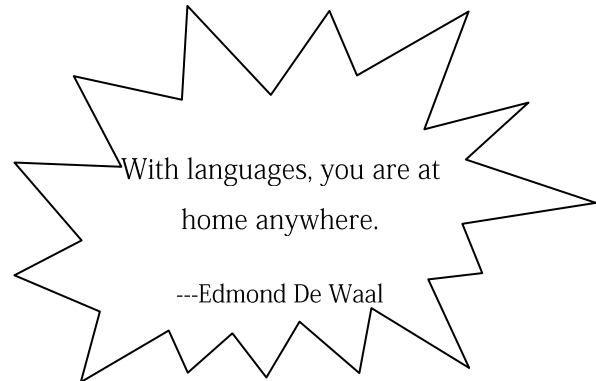
Students are expected to make up work in the case of an absence.
