



# Open Disclosure Zero Hour Choir

Zero Hour choir meets on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday from 7:30 – 8:10 a.m.

## **ATTENDANCE FOR THIS CLASS IS EXTREMELY IMPORTANT.**

Zero Hour was created specifically for students who cannot fit choir into their regular daily schedule, for those students who would like a second choir in their schedule, and for Juniors and Seniors who would like to continue their choir experience.

Because Zero Hour Choir is slightly different from choir classes offered during the regular school day, the grading for this class will be as follows:

- Students will receive 100 points for each day that they are on time and in attendance for class.
- Students who arrive late to class (after 7:35 a.m.) will need to sign in to receive partial credit for their daily points.
- Students arriving after 7:45 will be marked absent.\*\*\*
- Unexcused absences will result in a zero for the day.
- Class attendance/participation will be 50% of the quarter grade, with performances making up the other 50%.
- Students who are absent should present their admit to Ms.Curtis the day of their return, or parents may send Ms. C. an email notifying her of the absence. Excused absences will not count against a student's daily grade. However, 10 or more absences per semester will result in loss of credit for the class.
- If a student is in attendance at school, the student will be expected to be in attendance at Zero Hour rehearsal. **Students should not use this time to do homework, meet with another teacher or to serve detentions. These absences will not be excused.**

Students may be in both Jazz Band and in Zero Hour Choir by rotating their schedules between the two classes.
