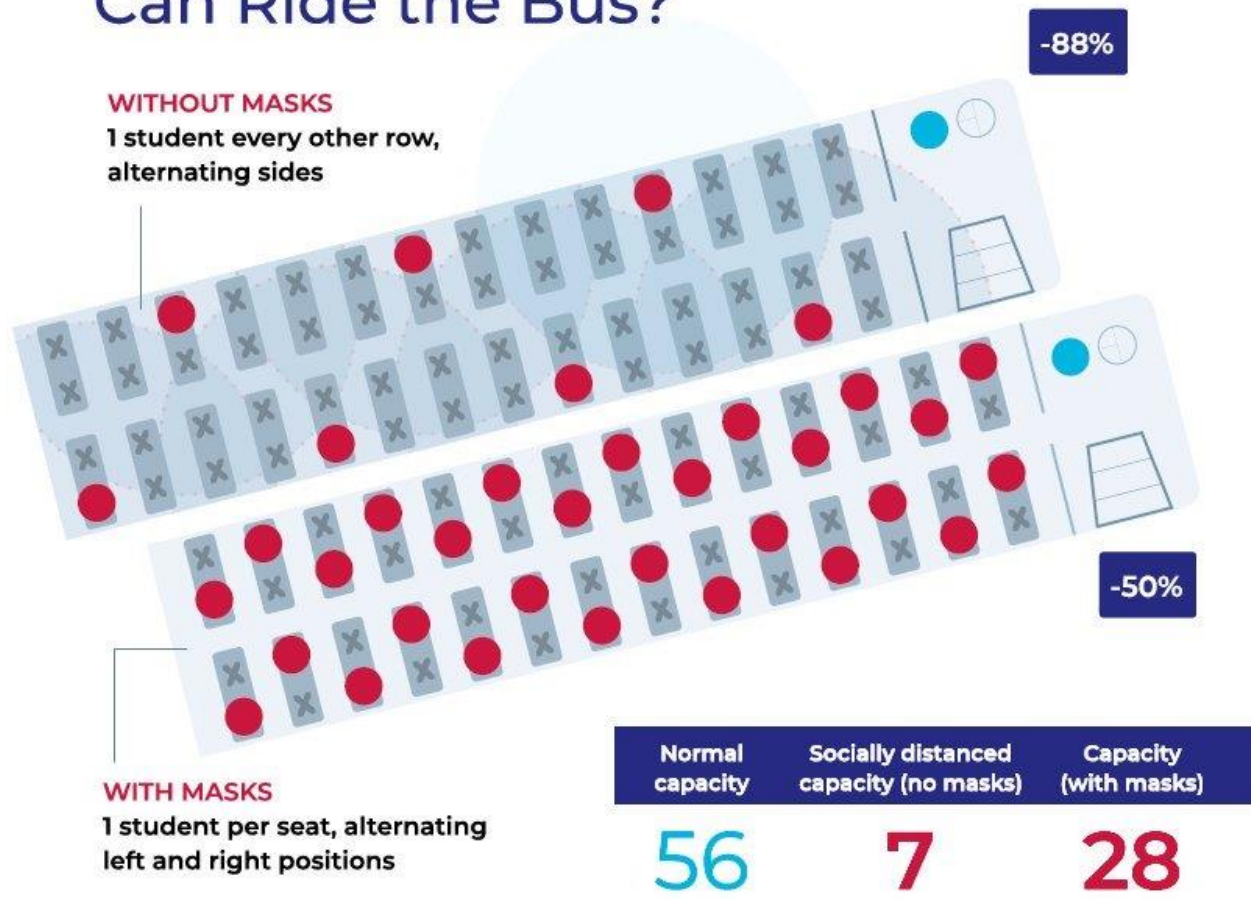


Transportation COVID-19 Protocol

1. Driver/Bus Aid
 - a. Daily self-symptom check; Can I Go to Work Today? (<http://www.parkhigh.org/covid-19-nurses-corner.html>)
 - b. Wash hands or use hand sanitizer before and after driving
 - c. Maintain physical distance of 6 feet when feasible
 - d. No hugs, handshakes or other physical greetings
 - e. **Masks required** at all times on the bus
 - f. Driver is assigned to one bus if possible.
2. Students
 - a. Use hand sanitizer upon entry to bus
 - b. **Masks required** to enter bus and are to be worn at all time
 - c. One student per seat. Siblings must sit together.
 - d. Assigned seating
 - e. Seats are marked where students can sit
3. Disinfection Process
 - a. Safety instructions per disinfecting product followed at all times
 - b. Gloves, eye protection and respirator worn during disinfection
 - c. Windows open to help improve ventilation
 - d. Bus is disinfected after each route
 - e. Bus seats are disinfected using a portable sprayer. All areas contacted by students and driver/aid (seats, railings) are sprayed. Areas allowed to air dry.
 - f. Garbage emptied between routes
4. Other Considerations
 - a. Open windows 2-3 inches to increase ventilation. Do not open more than 2-3 inches.
 - b. Provide hand sanitizer at entry of each bus
 - c. Place signage regarding hygiene protocol at various places on bus
